





## **OSMO APPLICATION TOOLS & TIPS**

## Osmo can be applied in any one of the following methods:

**ROLLER** – We recommend Osmo Rollers or Two Fussy Blokes 5mm Microfibre Sleeves to give a good, even finish. Rolling on larger flat surfaces works best.

**MICROFIBRE PAD** –The Osmo Microfibre Pad and Holder is recommended for any flat surface. The pad works best for chair legs.

**BRUSH** – Any good quality brush will work fine. We recommend either the Wooster Silver Tip or the Osmo brush. Brushing works best for small areas but any area can be brushed.

**RAG** – We don't recommend using rags as too much product is used and you run the risk of wiping off too much, resulting in wastage. If you wish to apply Osmo by rag you need to apply between 7-8 coats to ensure correct product build up.

**TROWEL AND BUFF** – Application method for the professional / competent applicators – not recommended for first time users.

**SPRAY** – Osmo is not designed to be sprayed (apart from spray wax – see tech data sheet for further information).

## **Maintenance**

**GENERAL CLEANING** – We recommend the Osmo Spray Cleaner (RFU) or Wash and Care (concentrate) for everyday cleaning of your Osmo surfaces (these are detergent free cleaners). Use daily on benchtops when wiping and whenever washing your floor.

**TOUGH MARKS / POLISHING** – We recommend Liquid Wax Cleaner in aerosol or liquid form. Use with the Osmo White Scuff Pads and Hand Holder to remove tough marks such as dried sauces. Also used for a regular polish to extend the life of your Osmo coating.
